The City of Ballarat has granted a permit for the cross country course to extend into the beautiful Victoria Park beyond the Pony Club grounds. The course has been built, designed and continually developed by Ewan Kellett. It provides a wide variety of fences on relatively flat terrain.

- DECLARATIONS:** Classes 3 – 6 are **Equestrian Victorian Interschool Qualifiers**: Please mark on entry form if you are eligible and wish to enter these classes along with the **name of your school**. Any entrant NOT noting a school shall be regarded as an open entry. All classes run will be subject to sufficient entries.
- PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE:** All EvA80, some EvA95 dressage and EvA80 showjumping will run Friday.
All other Dressage, EvA95 and EvA105 showjumping and EvA80 and EvA95 Cross Country will run Saturday
Remaining Showjumping and all other Cross Country – Sunday
- GEAR CHECK:** Riders onus – incorrect gear will result in elimination
- HORSE SUBSTITUTION:** Enquire via email with the Event Secretary
- ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:** On line at www.nominate.com.au All Riders must pay the entry fee, plus the Eventing levy \$25.00 and Facility Fee \$10.00/horse.
If the event is cancelled due to circumstance outside the control of the organisers an administration fee of 25% of all money paid by a rider will be retained by the organisers
If Riders scratch on or before the 28 April 2017 they shall receive a full refund less a \$15.00 administration fee
If Riders scratch after the 28 April 2017 they shall receive a refund of the camping and yard fees subject to the provision of a vet or medical certificate.
After the close of entries there is NO REFUND of entry fee for any reason
- STARTING TIMES:** Draw times on Nominate.
- GENERAL CONDITIONS:** The organising committee have the right to change, alter and delete the program as required. Neither the Organising Committee, Ballarat Pony Club, the City of Ballarat or EA accept any responsibility for any accident, damage or illness to horses, riders, grounds/park, spectators or any other person or personal property.
- INSPECTION OF X-COUNTRY:** Friday 2.00pm for EvA 80 and EvA95
Saturday 2.00pm for all other classes

STABLING:

Yards are available on site - \$30.00/yard for the duration of the competition, to be booked and paid for with entry. Riders will need to pay a \$30.00 cleaning bond which will be refunded if yards are left clean and tidy. If not the bond will be retained by the organising committee. Own yards may be erected if owner is camping. Yards must comply with EA Rules.

All yards to be cleaned and manure must be placed in designated areas

CAMPING:

Riders may camp at the Equestrian facilities in Victoria Park. There is a \$10.00 facility fee.

No Fires in Victoria Park. Showers and Toilets available
