PIERRE DE COUBERTIN AWARD AND OLYMPIC ACADEMY Melbourne Cricket Ground Friday 22 June 2018

Once again this year, we invite State Sporting Associations (SSA) to nominate:

- 1. <u>one athlete to receive the Pierre de Coubertin Award</u> and to take part in the annual Olympic Academy, and
- 2. <u>an additional two sport leaders</u>, from years 10, 11 or 12 to attend the full day program as your sport representatives.

Nominations must be submitted by Friday 1 June 2018.

The program is free of charge and students will be provided with refreshments throughout the day. Registrations will commence at 10:00am on the day, followed by:

- 10.30am 4.00pm Olympic Academy (Limited places available; lunch will be provided for students)
- 5.00pm 7.00pm Pierre de Coubertin Awards Ceremony

The Olympic Academy is a unique opportunity for athletes and sport leaders to:

- Interact with Olympians,
- Tour the National Sports Museum,
- Meet and engage with like-minded students, and
- Learn about the Olympic Movement and A.S.P.I.R.E. Australian Olympic Team values.

The Pierre de Coubertin Award recognises students who demonstrate values, which are consistent with the Olympic Movement through participation in sporting activities. It acknowledges Year 10, 11 and 12 students who, although may not be an elite athlete, demonstrate the values of the Olympic Movement in sport and their everyday lives.

PIERRE DE COUBERTIN AWARD SELECTION CRITERIA AND GUIDELINES (ONE ATHLETE)

The SSA must be on the current Olympic program and a member of the Victorian Olympic Council. At some stage throughout their sporting career, the selected athlete must:

- Be a registered member of the SSA
- Be enrolled in years 10, 11 or 12 and not have received the Award on a previous occasion.
- Have participated actively in the SSAs competition program with a consistently positive attitude
- Be actively involved in school or community sport, including but not limited to competing, volunteering, coaching, officiating, administration or club development
- Demonstrate the attributes consistent with the fundamental aims of the Olympic movement, and
- Submit a digital media, literacy or artistic piece that depicts an appreciation of Olympism in response to this year's theme: "Which Olympic athlete has been a role model to you and why?"

A digital media, literary or artistic piece related to the theme must accompany the nomination form otherwise it will be deemed invalid. All pieces submitted remain the property of the VOC and where appropriate may be used in official publications. Please note:

- Literary pieces must be a MAXIMUM of 300 words (typed) in length.
- Artistic pieces must be within the confines of 64x45cm or equivalent in 3D. An artistic piece could refer to, but is not limited to, a painting, collage or framed piece.
- Digital Media pieces refer to audio, video, and photo content that has been encoded (digitally compressed) i.e. converting audio and video input into a digital media file such as a Windows Media file. A digital media piece could refer to, but is not limited to, a musical recording, videography or PowerPoint presentation which is a MAXIMUM of 3min.

- 1. Call for nominations from your members by Friday 11 May circulating this letter and the attachments.
- 2. SSAs to rank the applicants, and select ONE award recipient plus TWO additional sport leaders.
- 3. SSAs to submit the nominations online by **Friday 1 June.**
