CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRIES CLOSE - Wednesday 3rd January 2018

- 1. The Organising Committee reserves the right to:
 - a) alter the classification of any class or modify conditions of entry or cancel the event,
 - b) withhold any prize or cancel any or all classes because of insufficient entries or lack of sponsorship money,
 - c) ballot any entry from a class
- 2. Disclaimer of liability -Neither the E.A., The Warrnambool Racing Club Inc., accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness caused to owners, riders, horses, spectators or any person or property whatsoever
- 3. Insurance All Owners and Competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore, strongly advised to take out Third party Insurance providing for full coverage for participation in Equestrian Events at home and abroad (away from home) and to keep the policy up to date. (NB: This insurance is included in E.A. (Vic. Branch) Inc. Membership).
- 4. Competitor licence to be produced on the day.
- All classes run under E.A. Rules.
- 6. Random Drug Testing may take place.
- 7. In all classes, other than class 1-4, all horses nominated must be currently registered with the E.A. and have a current competitor licence. All owners and rider must be financial members of the E.A.
- 8. Any horses not ready to jump when called may be eliminated.
- 9. DRESS Correct riding attire as specified by E.A. Showjumping Addendum is necessary at all times including walking the course.
- 10. PROTESTS accompanied by a \$20.00 fee, are to be lodged within 15 minutes of completion of class. Money to be refunded if protest is upheld.
- 11. All Competitors are responsible for picking up manure and other rubbish in the vicinity of the floats.
- 12. All horses to be mounted for presentation and riders to be in correct attire.
- 13. A copy of the draw will be available to participants.
- 14. SCRATCHINGS 75% of entry fee will be refunded if veterinary or medical certificate is produced within 48 hours of scratching
- 15. HELMETS TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILST MOUNTED.

Champion Thoroughbred of Carnival Sponsored by the Thoroughbred Owners and Trainers Association.

In recognition of the close relationship that has been established between thoroughbred racing and showjumping at the Warrnambool Summer Racing, a special award has been introduced for thoroughbred horses, particularly young horses, competing in the showjumping carnival.

The award will be based an aggregate points system for nominated thoroughbreds competing in events 5, 6, 7, 9, 10 & 11. Horses competing in these events will be awarded points on the following basis. Highest placed thoroughbred 12 pts, 2nd highest 10 pts, 3rd highest 8 pts, 4th highest 6 pts, 5th highest 4 pts, 6th highest 2 pts.

Eligibility for this award is subject to nomination form being completed with details of the horses breeding etc. being submitted prior to commencement of jumping on Saturday 6th January 2018. 1st Prize Horse Rug.

ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

Stabling

- 1. **Primary accommodation** area for visiting competitors will be located at the west end of the competition venue at the Warrnambool Race course.
- 2. **Secondary accommodation** area for visiting competitors will be at the Warrnambool Showgrounds approximately 5km away from the competition venue. If further information is required please don't hesitate to call the Warrnambool Showgrounds on 03) 5562 4644.

Access & Float Parking at Warrnambool Racecourse

- 1. Horse floats must enter through the Moore Street entrance to the Warrnambool Racecourse. Entry to the course on Friday 5th and on Saturday 6th is free, however, on Sunday 7th a pass is required for all persons. Competitor's passes will be issued upon receipt of entries. "Groom Passes" can be purchased in advance with entries for \$7.00 each. Otherwise normal admission prices will apply.
- 2. Portable yards must meet EA standards. <u>Taped yards are unacceptable.</u>
- 3. Competitors are reminded of the need to collect and deposit their horse manure and other litter, including hay, in the bins provided in the float park area. Holes dug by horses are to be filled in prior to leaving float park. Policing of these requirements will be undertaken by event officials.
- 4. Horses will not be permitted in the jumping arena or in the warm up area whilst racehorses are in the mounting yard or on the race track.

Competitor Accommodation and Meals

- 1. **Powered sites & Unpowered sites**, toilets and showers will be available at the Warrnambool Racecourse. A Camping Fee of **\$40 per powered camp** or **\$20 per unpowered camp** to be paid with entry fees.
- 2. Portable yards must meet EA standards. <u>Taped yards are unacceptable.</u>
- 3. Warrnambool has a wide selection of accommodation, however competitors intending to use motels are advised to book early as January is a peak holiday period.
