

Dressage Performance Medals

2018



Dressage Victoria is pleased to once again present the Performance Medal Awards, open to all current members of Equestrian Victoria.

In order to be eligible for an award, a combination must have achieved a minimum of three percentages in Official Competitive tests between the 11 December 2017 and the 30 November 2018, and all submitted percentages must meet or exceed the criteria laid out in the table below. Hors Concours scores, as well as Freestyle and Young Horse competitions, shall not be counted.

Please note that FEI Pony, FEI Junior, FEI Young Rider and FEI Grand Prix 16-25 results shall be counted as Elementary, Medium, Small Tour and Big Tour results respectively.

Nomination for the Performance Medal is free but must be made through the Application Form which can be found at:

- A rider will receive only the highest level medal they have qualified for; i.e. a Novice combination with 3 scores of 74% shall receive only a gold medal and not the bronze or silver.
- Horses must be registered from Victoria.

- Applicants must submit the date, competition and scores that they have achieved, via the webform on the Dressage Victoria page. If your results are not yet listed on the Nominate Database, please enclose copies of your test sheets, or signed result sheets.
- The Rider or their agent must be in attendance to receive their award at the presentation on the 8th December 2018 at Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre. Non-presented medals shall be forfeit and retained by Equestrian Victoria.
