

Friends of Werribee Horse Trials - 2014

Welcome to the Friends of Werribee Horse Trials for 2014. Please read this letter; there is a lot that you need to know and this is the way you will find out; it is up to all competitors to read this information:

Cross Country Video - An Eventful Life will be recording the cross country round of every competitor t. These recordings will be available for download after the event.

Scratchings - Should you need to scratch, please email friendsofwerribee@gmail.com or on the day (only) call 0433 576 381. Refund policy as per Eventing National Rules. Please be courteous to our judges, if you are not able to compete let us know.

Horse Numbers – The EV database identifies horses by their number not their name. If you do not supply your Horses EV number there is every chance your results will not be recorded.

Back numbers must be worn for the cross country phase. Bridle and/or saddle numbers must be worn on both sides of the horse for Dressage & Showjumping. Cross Country back numbers will be supplied at registration Indoor ONE, riders must supply their own back number holder.

Timetable –All dressage will be conducted on Saturday (except for Division 1 of Introductory on Friday afternoon), it is your responsibility to ensure that you present to the judge on time. Times are tight between classes and if you are late there may not be time to just slip in. Introductory SJ and CC is on Saturday. Preliminary SJ is on Saturday afternoon.

Showjumping course walks have been scheduled to commence 20 mins before the start time of each class. There will be one additional Course walk for introductory riders at 10.30am on Saturday morning. Be aware that you may need to walk the course before your dressage.

Riders are expected to ride in number order in all phases. Riders with multiple rides must give priority to Dressage, then Cross Country and then Show Jumping. Always send a representative if you will be late for a Ring.

Dressage Tests – The tests for this event are as listed in the official EV Eventing Handbook. For classes Intro, Prelim and Pre-Novice the 2011 EA EVENTING dressage tests apply (Prelim 1 and PN 2). For CNC***, CNC** and CNC* the 2009 FEI dressage apply (CCI***A, CCI*A).

Dressage Warm Up - In order to accommodate all entries dressage times on Saturday are tight. If you are late there will be no opportunity to fit you in so please make sure you are on time. All dressage rings are on sand and three dressage warm up areas have been allocated for the morning sessions:

- 1) Sand arena in Civinex paddock (at the end of indoor 2)
- 2) Alan Bruno Lawn (Outside administration building)
- 3) Sand Showjump warm up arena (on far side of SJ arenas)

Riders in Introductory dressage classes on Saturday please use the small sand show jump arena as your final warm up - you can also use the Alan Bruno lawn but you will not be marshaled from here. Preliminary riders can use the Civinex arena and the Alan Bruno Lawn to warm up.

In the afternoon Showjump arena 1 is available for dressage warm up for PN - CNC*** as well as the Alan Bruno Lawn. Please note that XC warm up for Intro will be in the sand SJ arena #2 from 1pm. Please keep off the Polo fields and the grass area to the left of the drive which is bunted off for the National Showjumping Championships. Thanks for your assistance and we hope you have a fantastic weekend.

Yards, Powered sites and Stables can be booked through WPNEC. Please be courteous to other competitors who may arrive late at night and ensure your park in your allocated site. Camping: There is ample space to camp and there are many water taps around the grounds. Showers are available in several locations.
