GREATER SHEPPARTON

Regulations & Event Guidelines

- 1. All riders and owners must be members of Equestrian Australia.
- 2. All horses nominated must hold current registration and grading papers from Equestrian Australia.
- Substitution of a nominated horse or rider may only take place within that nominated event and must be notified prior to the commencement of that event.
- 4. Junior & Young Rider Classes:- Horse and rider combinations that compete in Class 6 Young Rider are NOT eligible to compete in any Junior classes as a combination, i.e.: Class 9 or 15.
- 5. LIABILITY. Neither the committee nor the venue owner nor any of the staff or agents shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, damage, loss or for any matter that may happen from any cause or circumstance whatsoever, to exhibitors competitors or members or their agents or to anyone on the grounds or to any animal exhibited or property brought on to the grounds for any loss claim matter circumstance or event whatsoever in conjunction with or arising out of or attributable to the Festival or any journey to or from the event. It is also understood that in no circumstances shall the committee it's agents or employees be liable for any loss damages claims or costs occasioned or suffered by any exhibitor, competitor members directly howsoever arising, including without limitation losses damages claims or costs as a result of any negligence, and you agree to indemnify and save harmless to the committee the venue owner or lessees, their agents employees from and against any liability out of such loss, damage claims or costs.
- 6. Any protest must be made in writing and within 20 minutes of the event and accompanied by \$50 non refundable unless protest is upheld.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
- 8. Entries will not be considered accepted until all monies are cleared. All stabling fees must be paid by close of entries, or you will forfeit your booking.
- 9. Entries submitted electronically will not be accepted until entry fees have been deposited in the nominated bank account.
- 10. REFUNDS: Any refund requested prior to entries closing will be made in full, less 15% admin fee. Any refund requested after entries have closed, a vet or doctors certificate must be forwarded within 3 days of the completion of the event for a refund, less 25% admin fee (Refund applicable to scratched horse or rider only).
- 11. The Committee reserves the right to swab horses.
- 12. The Committee reserves the right at their discretion to alter or amend any of the above conditions and to modify the program or cancel the event.
- 13. Dogs must be on leads and secured at all times. No dogs are allowed in practice or competition arenas. W B Hunter Reserve is Council Property, & COGS reserve the right to impound any non secured dogs.
- 14. No Yards are to be erected around power outlets, or interfere with power leads to these outlets. Only ONE power Outlet PER TRUCK.
- 15. Competitors in Ring 2 (sand arena) will not be required to jump in draw order in the first round unless the event is a one round class. (Art 239)
- 16. Submission of an entry signifies acceptance of these regulations.

Entries must be accompanied by full entry fee (See Reg. 9 & 10) No phone entries will be accepted.

Please note that W B Hunter Reserve will NOT be available BEFORE Tuesday 8th November from 8 am – Stables/Yards will not have been erected prior to this time.




