Under the Australian Sports Commission's Updating Policy all NCAS Coaches in every sport must complete professional development activities ("updating") on a regular basis.

- 1. To maintain accreditation all coaches must be actively coaching. Therefore points are automatically earned via this pursuit.
- 2. All coaches must attend a compulsory EA Coach updating clinic once every two years
- 3. Coaches must earn a minimum number of points per year that correspond with their *level of accreditation*.
