Senior Squad

Development Squad

The Development squad has been able to engage members with an online presentation from 5* judge Suzie Hoevanaars. Suzie spoke on the judge's role and perspectives. The success of this was followed up with another online presentation with music specialist Gaynor Colbourn (from the UK). With restrictions limiting contact the squad has plans to continue online for the moment.

Smaller mentoring groups have been conducted for the upgrading of candidates with 3 new A grade judges being the result of the DJEP continued work.
