



# Equestrian Victoria AOR LEADERBOARD POINTS SYSTEM

## Points system for the AOR Leaderboard System.

1. Leaderboard Points will be awarded based on percentage only (not placing as in previous years)
  - Between 60% to 61.999% = 1 point
  - Between 62% to 63.999% = 2 points
  - Between 64% to 65.999% = 3 points
  - Between 66% to 67.999% = 4 points
  - Between 68% to 69.999% = 5 points
  - Between 70% to 71.999% = 6 points
  - 72% and over = 7 points
2. Points are awarded to each horse and rider combination
3. Points will be awarded for scores 60% or higher
4. Effective dates for points are July 1 to June 30 (Equestrian Victoria membership year)
5. Points will only be allocated to riders with a current Equestrian Victoria Membership
6. Points will be awarded for results gained at official EA events
7. Points will NOT be awarded for events with restricted entry e.g. Youth championships, State and National Championships (both AOR, and state based), Dressage Festival and separate team competitions.
8. Points are awarded for a level – points accrued at different levels will be recorded separately – i.e. not cumulative across levels.
9. Cumulative points will apply only in the calculation of the overall winner of the AOR Leaderboard annually.
10. Levels will be calculated for EA (Preliminary, Novice, Elementary, Medium and Advanced) and FEI (Small Tour, Medium Tour, Big Tour)
11. Where there are separate official competitions (classes) for ponies, OTT, etc, Leaderboard points will be allocated to those competitions, with points allocated as per the Percentage achieved for that competition.
12. It is the rider's responsibility to check their AOR status and, if eligible, to ensure that they are listed on the draw and the results. It is most important that the scorer has your AOR status as this will ensure that your points are correctly recorded for the Leader Board.

13. If there is no AOR checkbox on an entry form please contact the Organising Committee for that event.
14. If your AOR status has been omitted from the draw, document that you have asked the scorer to amend the results sheet e.g. by sending them an email. If "AOR" is not marked on the results received by the EV Office points will not be awarded, if you notice this please email [info@equestrianvictoria.com.au](mailto:info@equestrianvictoria.com.au)
15. Provisional monthly scores will be published on the Victorian AOR Facebook page as soon as possible after the previous month's events. All queries regarding the monthly points should be directed to Equestrian Victoria, [info@equestrianvictoria.com.au](mailto:info@equestrianvictoria.com.au) and should be received within seven (7) days of publication on Facebook.
16. Any disputes regarding Leaderboard points will be referred to the AOR Committee for resolution. It is up to the rider to note "AOR" on their entries
17. Riders must be 21 (or in the year they turn 21) in order to nominate AOR on their entries
