### WELCOME

This Handbook contains information and schedules for the 2013-2014 Official Horse Trials in Victoria. Any alterations to details will be published on the EV website.

### **GENERAL REGULATIONS**

Before making an entry, competitors should carefully read the EA National Eventing Rules. All Official Horse Trials are held under EA Rules and making an entry in these Trials implies acceptance of those Rules. For any eventuality not covered in the Rules and any international events the FEI Rules for Eventing should be referred to.

### **EQUESTRIAN AUSTRALIA MEMBER-SHIP**

Riders competing in all classes must be full Senior or Junior members of their EA state branch to compete. Horses competing in Introductory classes do not have to hold current Performance Cards but must be registered.

EA no longer offers day insurance to non-members.

### **EV MEMEMBERSHIP CARDS:**

All riders must present a valid EA membership card when registering at RETIRING & WITHDRAWING an event. Any rider without a card must sign a statutory declaration stating they are a current EV member (and therefore covered by insurance) BEFORE being allowed to ride. Any rider not able to produce a valid membership card for any reason is subject to a \$20 fine at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

Most draws are now available through either EV or club websites and e-mail - so please remember to supply your e-mail address for ease and speedy distribution of times.

### **DECLARATIONS**

All competitors must declare their intention to WITHDRAW, by the dates and times stated in the various schedules.

### **DRESSAGE TESTS**

All events will use current EA tests OR current FEI tests as published in this handbook.

Dressage tests are available for download from:

www.vic.equestrian.org.au

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they are on time for their dressage test. It remains entirely the discretion of the Organising Committee whether to slot riders who are late into another time.

### **ELIMINATED / RETIRED COMPETI-TORS**

After being eliminated or retiring for any reason competitors must leave the course immediately. A competitor must WALK their horse off the course either mounted or unmounted. Violators may be fined at the discretion of the EA Technical Delegate.

If you do not intend to present for a phase, please inform the secretary.

### **NUMBER HOLDERS**

Competitors must wear bridle or saddle numbers on BOTH sides of the • To alter the advertised times horse for dressage and showjumping phases. At no event is the wearing of back numbers enforceable in the dressage or showjumping phases.

All competitors must have their own back number holder and medical armband for the Cross Country phase.

Long hair is to be well secured so as not to obscure your back number when on the cross country course. Officials must be able to see your number at all times.

### **BACK PROTECTORS**

As per the FEI and National Eventing Rules, Back Protectors must be worn for the Cross Country phase.

### **DOGS**

If allowed to attend an event dogs should be kept on a lead.

### **PRIZE GIVING**

Please ensure you stay to collect your prize, as a courtesy to the Event Organisers and their sponsors. Organising Committees are under no obligation to provide prizes to place getters who do not remain for the prize giving ceremony.

### **CLEANLINESS OF PROPERTIES**

Most Horse Trials are held on private property; please keep them clean so property owners continue to support our events.

### **RESERVATION OF RIGHT**

The Organisers of Horse Trials held under EA Rules have the right to:-

- To cancel any class or event
- To divide any class
- To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- To refuse any entry



### **VOLUNTEERS**

Many events now offer a rebate on entries to those riders who provide a a current event licence for prelimivolunteer. If you are not riding or have some hours free please offer your assistance to the event Organisers.

### **ENTRY FEE REFUNDS**

As per 2013 Eventing National Rules: Entry Fees will be refunded in full (an administration fee of up to 10% may be deducted) to competitors who withdraw before the close of entries. There will be no refund of entry fees for withdrawals after the close of entries. However stabling/ yard and camping fees will be refunded in full.

### **AMBULANCE COVER**

All riders should be members of the Ambulance Service. If you are not a member and require transport to hospital in a civil ambulance, you will Junior CNCJ\* Classes: be liable for any costs.

### **NUMBERS AND CLASS INDICATORS**

Each obstacle shall be numbered and marked according to the colour indicator code.

### **OWNERS**

Owners of all horses competing in all Official Classes must be current members of their EA state branch.

### **REGISTRATION OF HORSES**

All horses in INTRO classes and above must be registered with their EA state branch before being entered for any event and must have Preliminary Classes: nary and above.

All horses competing must be registered and micro chipped through **Equestrian Victoria.** 

Horses must be entered for events in their full registered names and their registered EA Number

### **AGE OF COMPETITORS**

CNC\*\*\* Classes:

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 18.

### CNC\*\* Classes:

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 16.

### CNC\* Classes:

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 14.

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 14 until the end of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 18.

Pre Novice Classes:

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 13.

Junior Pre Novice Classes:

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 13 until the end of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 18.

Young Rider Classes:

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 21.

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 12.

**Introductory Classes:** 

From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 11.

### **MINIMUM AGE OF HORSES**

- One Day Events 4 years
- Two Day Events 5 years

### **FEI Registration**

All horses and Riders competing in international classes (CIC or CCI) must also be registered with the FEI

### **RIDING DOWN**

Riding Down one level from a higher level for which a horse is qualified, carries no penalty. Riding Down two or more levels will incur twenty one penalties, to be added to the total of faults for the three phases. It is the responsibility of the competitor to inform the Organising Committee at the time of entry that they are riding down two or more levels.

### **MEDICAL ARMBANDS**

It is vital the information on your medical armband is correct and up to date. Please check regularly that this information, including contact details is current


