TERMS AND CONDITIONS

VICTORIAN STATE TITLE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- The organising committee must run a warm up class and the Junior, Young Rider and Senior Title.
- The organising committee, at their discretion, may run the Children Title but is not compulsory.
- The organising committee will adhere to the heights and class stipulations per Jumping Victoria's State Titles Guidelines.
- Where the organising committee decides to run more than the Senior, Young Rider and Junior Title, each HORSE is only eligible to compete in ONE title championship. This rule does not apply to any speed championship.

VICTORIAN COUNTRY TITLE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- The organising committee must run a warm up class and the Senior Country Title.
- The organising committee, at their discretion, may run the Young Rider and Junior Country Title but is not compulsory.
- The organising committee will adhere to the heights and class stipulations per Jumping Victoria's State Titles Guidelines.
- Where the organising committee decides to run more than the Senior Country Title, each HORSE is only eligible to compete in ONE title championship. This rule does not apply to any speed championship.

VICTORIAN INDOOR TITLE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- The organising committee must run a warm up class and the Senior Indoor Title.
- The organising committee, at their discretion, may run the Young Rider and Junior Indoor Title but is not compulsory.
- The organising committee will adhere to the heights and class stipulations per Jumping Victoria's State Titles Guidelines.
- Where the organising committee decides to run more than the Senior Indoor Title, each HORSE is only eligible to compete in ONE title championship. This rule does not apply to any speed championship.

ELIGIBILITY FOR TITLES

All riders competing in the Title events must be current financial members of EA.

- **Junior Rider:** A rider is considered a Junior Rider from the commencement of the year of their 12th birthday until the end of the year of their 18th birthday.
- **Young Rider:** A rider is considered a Young Rider from the commencement of the year of their 16th birthday until the end of the year of their 21st birthday.
- **Senior Rider:** A rider is considered a Senior Rider from the commencement of the year of their 18th birthday until the end.

A rider may compete in two consecutive divisions, i.e. Junior and Young Rider or Young Rider and Senior. Riders whose age allows them to compete in two divisions may do so but on different horses. A rider may ride no more than three horses in any one division.

It is the responsibility of the Organising Committee to make sure all riders competing in the Title events are current financial members of Equestrian Australia.

MEDICATION CONTROL

Medication control may be required. Please read the full policy via the Equestrian Australia website.

FUNDING

Jumping Victoria through Equestrian Victoria may contribute sponsorship. This funding is provided based on required conditions being met and delivered.

RISK MANAGEMENT

The organising committee will need to consider the following:

- The appointment of a person responsible for safety and risk management at the event (where no one in particular is appointed, the Event Director or the Club President assumes this responsibility).
- Provide contact details of emergency personnel and agencies such as first aid and ambulance services, nearby hospitals, treating vet, farrier and published in event schedule.
- The identification of risks for the event, including the competition(s) and, of course, the venue.
- A system to ensure the waiver/release forms are signed by participants as appropriate.
- An incident reporting system that is communicated to all involved in the event.
- Written reports to be kept post event.
- An incident/accident investigation system that helps prevent a recurrence of the incident.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The organising committee will need to adhere to the following:

- Jumping Victoria to be in the class name.
- Photos of the winner must be taken and supplied to Jumping Victoria for commercial use.
- Rugs awarded to the winner (whereby not supplied by Jumping Victoria) must have the Jumping Victoria Logo displayed.
- The following are guidelines formulated by the Jumping Victoria Committee to assist Organising Committees in the conduct of the Jumping Victoria Title Championships. Jumping Victoria reserves the right to amend these rules at any time.
- The Jumping Victoria Titles is an Event conducted for and on behalf of Jumping Victoria Committee.
- The Organising Committee is required to conduct the event within guidelines published by the Jumping Victoria Committee.

SENIOR STATE TITLES

VICTORIAN SENIOR STATE TITLES

The Victorian Young Rider Title will be awarded to the combination that scores the highest points over minimum two rounds and maximum three rounds.

Riders must be 18+ years to be eligible to compete.

The President of the Ground Jury: FEI or EA Level 3.

Total Minimum Prize Money: \$6 000

Minimum Overall Winner Prize Money: \$1 000

Points will be awarded for each competitor with the winner receiving 1 more point than the number of competitors in the class. Second will be awarded two less than the winner, third will receive three less than the winner etc with the last placed rider receiving 1 pt.

Eliminated, Retired, Disqualified, Withdrawn and Did Not Start combinations do not receive points.

Order of Draw: Reverse order of placings in Round 1

Minimum Height: 1.45m

Placings: 1st – 6th place.

Prize Money Minimum Total: \$3 000

Points will be awarded for each competitor with the winner receiving 1 more point than the number of competitors in Competition 1. Second will be awarded two less than the winner, third will receive three less than the winner etc.

Eliminated, Retired, Disqualified, Withdrawn and Did Not Start combinations do not receive points

Eliminated, Retired, Disqualified, Withdrawn and Did Not Start combinations do not receive points

OVERALL OVER 2 DAYS

Points from both rounds will be added together to determine the Victoria Senior State Title Winner.

Riders must score in BOTH competitions to be eligible for the overall rankings.

Prize

Winner: Minimum \$1 000 in prize money + Rug + Rosette OR Sash.

Note: Rug and rosette to be provided by Jumping Victoria.

Placings: may receive prizes at the discretion of the organising committee.

OVERALL OVER 3 DAYS

Points from three rounds will be added together to determine the Victoria Senior State Title Winner.

Riders must score in ALL competitions to be eligible for the overall rankings.

Prize

Winner: Minimum \$1 000 in prize money + Rug + Rosette OR Sash.

Note: Rug and rosette to be provided by Jumping Victoria.

Placings: may receive prizes at the discretion of the organising committee.



YOUNG RIDER STATE TITLES

VICTORIAN YOUNG RIDER STATE TITLES

The Victorian Young Rider Title will be awarded to the combination that scores the highest points over minimum two rounds and maximum three rounds.

Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21 are eligible to compete.

It is at the committee/organisers discretion on point allocation across the classes.

Eliminated, Retired, Disqualified, Withdrawn and DNS combinations do not receive points.

Eliminated, Retired, Disqualified, Withdrawn and DNS combinations do not receive points.
