

The EV Show Horse committee met on September 13th and is pleased to submit the following summary of business.

<p><b>Owner Rider Class for Shows</b></p>	<p>In preparation of the upcoming OTT and Owner Rider Show in December, the Show Horse Committee are currently reviewing the existing terminology for the Owner Rider class. All changes are expected to be finalised for the December Show program.</p>
<p><b>Measuring Dates at Upcoming Show Horse Events</b></p>	<p>Measuring will be offered at the upcoming events in 2022 and early 2023.</p> <p>With the measuring stand now ready for use at Tatura, future measuring dates at Tatura will also be implemented in collaboration with Shepparton Council.</p> <p>Dates for measuring at future Show Horse events are currently in review however, measuring will be offered at WPNEC for the following events:</p> <p>December (OTT and Owner Rider Show) – Bookings will open in mid-November</p> <p>January (Summer Show) - Bookings will open in mid-December</p> <p>February (Barastoc) - Bookings will open before the end of December</p>
<p><b>Victorian State Representative on the EASH Committee</b></p>	<p>Lorri Mansell has been ratified to continue on as the Victorian Representative on the EA Show Horse Committee for an additional 3 years.</p>
<p><b>EV Office</b></p>	<p>Adriana will be supporting the Show Horse Committee and will also be the primary contact for any measuring enquiries.</p>
<p><b>Barastoc</b></p>	<p>Planning for Barastoc is already underway with the Show Horse Committee currently reviewing the potential to implement additional classes for Barastoc 2023.</p>
<p><b>Helmet Tagging</b></p>	<p>Lorri Mansell engaged the EASH Committee regarding any requirements for helmet tagging at Show Horse events and was advised that helmet tagging is not mandatory for EA Show Horse events. Any changes will be communicated by EA.</p>
