

Victorian Performance Points Allocation - 2025/26

The Victorian Performance Points Allocation is used to determine the recipients of the following annual awards:

- Victorian Horse of the Year
- OTT Horse of the Year
- Victorian Rider of the Year
- Victorian Young Rider of the Year

These awards are points-based and are open to all eligible Victorian EA Eventing Licence holders competing in any EA-sanctioned eventing competition nationwide.

The performance period runs from 1 July to 30 June each year (from post-Melbourne 3DE to post-Melbourne 3DE).

Eligibility:

In order to be eligible for **rider** awards in Victoria, a rider must be a current member of Equestrian Victoria, holding a licence appropriate for the level at which the rider is competing and must not have received any periods of suspension during the 12 months of the applicable competition year. This includes a period of suspension imposed during the year, but served after the close of the points allocation period. Suspension served during the next year will not affect the that years' eligibility unless another suspension is received.

Positive swabs also prevent eligibility for both rider AND horse. If positive results are received for a horse (or positive drug test for rider) that was swabbed during the 12 month eligibility period, the rider and horse will be ineligible for awards and all points removed with awards reallocated.
