

INFRA RED (IR) THERMOMETER TESTING

Equestrian Victoria objectives in managing the COVID-19 crisis remains to ensure the safety of our members and visitors while maintaining a high level of operational capability. Each person who enters an Equestrian Victoria event will have their body temperature measured, using a non-contact infra-red thermometer.



Any Equestrian Victoria member, competitor, visitor or spectator who records a temperature of 37.5°C or over will be refused entry to the event and or premises and strongly recommended that they seek medical advice.

Testing Frequency – On arrival each day of training competition

All people MUST maintain a minimum of 1.5m physical distancing

Where – at the ENTRY GATE ON ARRIVAL if manned or at the EVENT OFFICE.

General Guidelines - measuring surface body temperature and using

- Subject to clean, dry forehead.
- Hold the device out at arm's length
- Align device 5 ~ 15cm from the forehead
- Press trigger to complete temperature check

Measuring distance: 5 ~ 15cm

- If temperature reads 37.3°C or above the tester will call your supervisor and after a cool down period of 10 mins, will retest.

Person temperature of 37.5°C and above will be refused entry

PPE must be worn by the person carrying out the test

- Safety glasses
- Face mask
- Nitrile gloves
- Lab coat



Symptoms

- Fever
- Shortness of breath
- Cough
