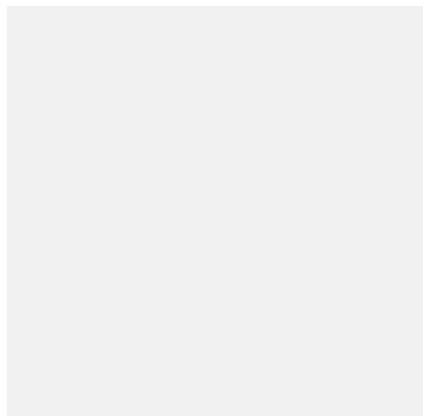

Event Secretary. All Riders must pay the entry fee, plus the Eventing levy \$25.00 and FEI Swabbing Fee if applicable

If Riders scratch on or before the close of entries they shall receive a full refund less a \$15.00 administration fee  
If Riders scratch after the close of entries they shall receive a refund of the camping and yard fees subject to the provision of a vet or medical certificate.
