Entry Requirements - wait list/refunds

All riders must pay the class entry fee, a facility fee of \$25 per horse (for the weekend) and the Victorian Eventing Levy (VEL) of \$35 per horse.

It is a condition of entry that ALL entrants ACCEPT and agree to be bound by the REFUND and cancellation policies as outlined below.

The Organising Committee shall adopt the following Refund Policy: The closing date for entries is 26th October 2026.

If a rider withdraws BEFORE the closing date, they will receive a FULL refund of all monies paid LESS a \$20 administration fee. If a rider withdraws on or after the closing date, they do NOT receive a refund of the entry or Victorian Eventing Levy for any reason whatsoever.

After close of entries - Riders are entitled to a refund of any yard fees paid only.

Riders on the waiting lists (if applicable) will receive a full refund after the close of entries if they have NOT been offered a place in the class. In all other instances arising from this event, the EA Eventing National Refund Policy applies.

Please note: The Cancellation Policy in the National Refund Policy states "that IF the event is cancelled (e.g., due to COVID-19 outbreak or adverse weather) the Organisers are entitled to retain up to 50 % of all monies received".
