There will be opportunity for training and assessment of Riding, Horse Management and Coaching. Candidates will ride for each other as Demonstration Riders. This is a great opportunity for riders wanting riding components of Riding certificates to be assessed.

Remember, in all cases of assessment you must demonstrate Competency to have your slips signed by the Coach Educator. Your slips will not be signed off if you are deemed Not Yet Competent.

When you register, please ensure that you complete the question: "**What is your aim in doing this workshop?**" For example, please state exactly what tasks you are hoping to have training on or would like to have assessed. Candidates should have purchased the '*Introductory Horse Management and Introductory Riding*' workbooks, and if these have been completed, the '*Introductory Coaching*' workbook.

If you are hoping to be assessed for Coaching, Lesson Plans should be ready and be submitted prior to the day.

The first Clinic is on the 4th of August and will be for Introductory candidates. The cost \$200 for the day (includes lunch, morning tea & afternoon tea). To Register as a Coach Candidate for this Clinic, please follow the Bookings link below.
