YOUNG HORSE CLASSIC

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The *Young Horse Classic Eventing Horse Challenge* provides owners and breeders the opportunity to showcase the potential of their 4, 5, 6 and 7 year-old horses at a series of 4 Victorian Horse Trials.

The aim of these classes is to encourage breeders and trainers to produce and present the correct type of young horse which is considered to be the best material to develop into a top level three day event horse.

We are looking for 4, 5, 6 and 7 year old promising eventing stars to be judged as follows:

- Each event will offer a separate section for horses as follows:
- EvA65 for the 4 & 5 Year Old (born August 2017 – July 2019)
- EvA80 for the 5 & 6 Year Old (born August 2016 - July 2018)
- EvA95 for the 6 & 7 Year Old (born August 2015 – July 2017)

The classes are for only competitors entering these classes and will accumulate to an overall winner at the end of the season.

Prizes for Each Class at each event will include trophy rug and:

- 1st - \$250.00 cash
- 2nd - \$150.00 cash
- 3rd - \$50.00 cash

Overall series winners in each section (EvA65, EvA80, EvA95) will receive prize money of \$500.00 with the runner up to receive \$250.00

Horses must compete at a minimum of 3 events to be considered for the overall winners award.

Points for the series will be accumulated from each individual event with their best 3 scores counting towards the overall total:

- 1st placing – 6 points
- 2nd placing – 5 points
- 3rd placing – 4 points
- 4th placing – 3 points
- 5th placing – 2 points
- 6th placing – 1 point

In the event of a tie of points the winner would be based off the least cross country penalties over the series, then least show jumping penalties to decide the overall winner.

Horses may compete in multiple levels (5 and 6yo are eligible for 65cm/80cm and 80cm/95cm), however their best 3 scores must come from the same level. Eg a 5 yo may compete in 1 x 65cm classes and 3 x 80cm classes. Only points from the 3 x 80cm classes will count towards the overall total.
