Competition Notes:

Classes 1 & 2

The Prix St Georges will be held in the morning followed by the Grand Prix 16 -25. Arena familiarisation /Warm up for Class 1 will be on the same morning prior to start of the class. Approximate start time of Class 1 will be 9.30am

Class 3 – The Grand Prix will be held during the afternoon with Arena familiarisation/Warm up early in the afternoon prior to the start of the class. Approximate start time of class will be 3.00pm

IMPORTANT: Entries will be capped to a maximum of 16 combinations overall. If your entry exceeds the capped limit for the class you may opt to be waitlisted or your fee will be refunded in full. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. **QUALIFICATIONS:** This event will be run in accordance with EA Dressage Rules 2020 and EA General Regs.

Stabling information:

A limited number of stables are available for use on the night of 30 November. PSG & 16-25 GP horses staying overnight must vacate their stables & venue by midday on 1st December.

ENTRY FEE: \$55 per test

ADMINISTRATION FEE: \$12 Per entry

FACILITY FEE: \$15 Per horse

STABLE FEE: \$66 overnight includes bedding Grand Prix Horses: Half day afternoon \$55

COVID-19 recommendations will be used for arrivals and check in, we ask that you work with us to ensure this competition is compliant with Equestrian Victoria's COVID requirements. Social distancing is required, and masks worn when not riding. Competitors and their 'one' support person will be temperature checked on arrival. Hand Sanitiser is available at several locations around the venue. Full information will be emailed on COVID procedures prior to your arrival. Competitors must leave the venue after they have competed. Test sheets will be emailed to you and if you place 1st, 2nd or 3rd your ribbon will be mailed to you. As per COVID regulations on 29 October 2020 NO spectators can attend this competition. If COVID-19 travel restrictions are in place at the time of this competition ONLY competitors who are 'allowed' to travel to and from Drysdale may attend the competition.
