The Qualification Process for the National Selection of Victorian Interschool Eventing Combinations.

- The riders submit their best four results from competitions between October 1st October 2019 and 15th June 2020
- All submitted results must be from official EA Horse Trials (no pony club or Open Classes)
- A Minimum Eligibility Requirement (MER)* must be attained in order for the score to count.
- Horse trials are open to primary and secondary riders but EA age criteria at some levels apply.
- Only results at the level riders are applying for will be considered.
- Equestrian Victoria in consultation with the VEIS will select a panel to consider results and nominate the Victorian team of four riders at each level. This panel will not include any parent of an Interschool rider.
- The process on how to submit results will be advised in June 2020.

Policy Review:

This process will be reviewed in August 2020 and any feedback will be welcomed at that point.

NOTE: An MER is 55% or better in the dressage; no jumping penalties cross country and less than 30 time penalties; no more than 16 jumping penalties in show jumping, (time penalties are allowed).
