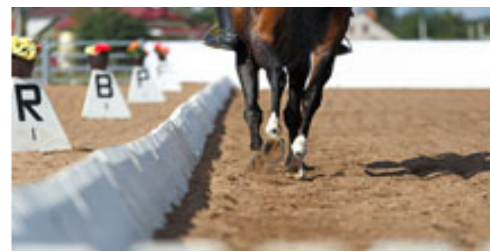

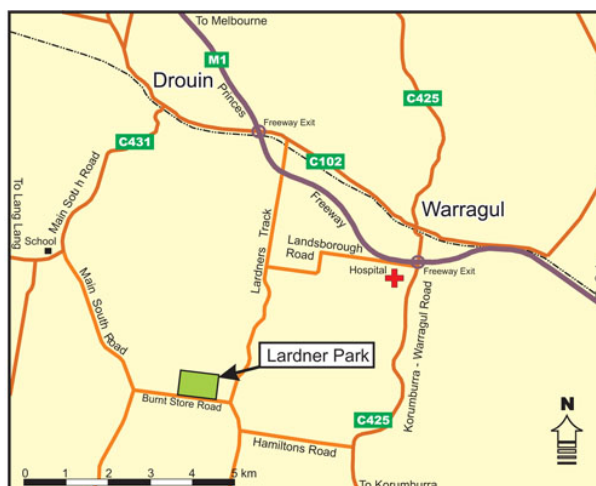
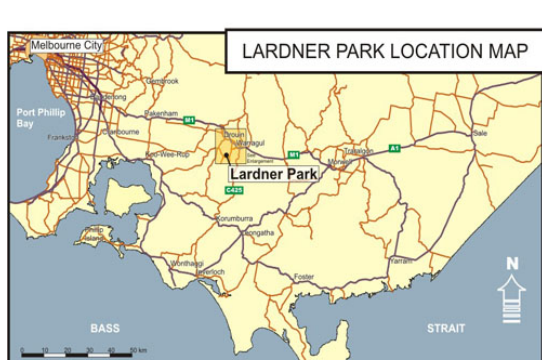

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ALL riders and owners entered in official Equestrian Australia classes MUST be current members of Equestrian Australia and must:
  - Hold current registration and grading papers for their horses from the Equestrian Australia
  - Understand that grading will be in accordance with the National Equestrian Australia grading system
  - Dress according to standard as per Equestrian Australia regulations
  - Abide by all Equestrian Australia rules
- There will be no refund of entry fees unless a scratching is notified via Global Entries prior to close of entries OR a vet or medical certificate is supplied within 14 days of the competition – in this case 50% of your entry will be deducted from refund
- Farmworld Equestrian Expo Equestrian Expo reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.

- Competitors in showjumping event must compete in the order as directed on the draw
- Farmworld Equestrian Expo reserves the right to refuse entries and also the right to swab horses
- Horses must only be exercised on the designated practice area provided (refer to venue map)
- DOGS are strictly NOT PERMITTED
- Children under the age of 14 years are to be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 5 MUST BE UNDER DIRECT SUPERVISION AT ALL TIMES
- All prize money will be paid either by cash or cheque which may be sent by mail following the event
- Farmworld Equestrian Expo extends no responsibility for the loss or damage to any exhibit, property or person
- Farmworld Equestrian Expo reserves the right to accept or reject any entry, or to vary conditions to any class, to cancel any event or class without assigning any reason, or alter the order of starting where considered appropriate.
- Farmworld Equestrian Expo is made available to competitors for the purpose of competing and not for commercial activities (such as promotions and sales) unless prior approval has been obtained from event management.
- Parking – please follow signs and directions from parking marshalls
- Manure disposal – please put all manure in allocated areas (please refer to venue map)
- Rubbish – please put all rubbish in bins provided
- Horses – competitors' horses will under no circumstances be permitted inside the public access areas, to maintain the safety of the large number of visitors attending the event. Competitors' horses are only permitted to be in the designated day parking, camping, competition arena, warm up areas and the stables.
- Catering – a canteen will be operating for the duration of the event
- Showers – are available between 6am and 9pm (please refer to venue map)
- Camping – there is no power unless you have booked a powered site
- Please be mindful of others and do not run generators late. Please note no campfires are permitted, however gas stoves and BBQs are permitted if they are clear of flammable items and a fire extinguisher is in close proximity
- Each competitor will receive two day passes to Farmworld. If you are competing on two days you will receive an additional two day passes. If more passes are required they are available \$18 per pass
- Competitors should arrive between 1pm and 9pm on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> April, or alternatively Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> to Sunday the 10<sup>th</sup> of April, between the hours of 6am and 9pm. If arriving outside these hours please contact 0499476313 to make arrangements PRIOR TO THE EVENT
- SPEED LIMIT INSIDE THE VENUE IS 10K/H
- Each horse may only start in two classes each day
- ALL riders MUST SIGN IN ON ARRIVAL & SIGN A WAIVER at the event office, please refer to venue map
