All classes will be conducted under the effective Equestrian Australia National Eventing Rules and Regulations (effective as at 1 January 2026).

The Draw will be published on Event Secretary and sent to each Riders email as provided with their online entry. Altering your entry or substituting a horse - (Additional Fees may apply) Enquire with Event Secretary. This Event will adhere to the EA National Refund Policy. (Please refer to the policy for full details) If a rider withdraws BEFORE the closing date, they will receive a FULL refund of all monies paid LESS a \$20 administration fee. If a rider withdraws on or after the closing date, they do NOT receive a refund of the entry or Victorian Eventing Levy for any reason whatsoever. Riders will NOT be substituted from any Waiting lists AFTER the close of entries. Riders on the waiting lists (if applicable) will receive a full refund after the close of entries if they have NOT been offered a place in the class. EVENT CANCELLATION POLICY- The EA National Refund Policy shall be applied. It is a condition of entry to this event that ALL entrants accept and agree to be bound by the REFUND and CANCELLATION policies as outlined.
