HORSE SUBSTITUTION:	At secretaries and committees' discretion.
ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:	If the event is cancelled due to unforeseen reasons an administration fee of \$50 will apply. Scratching's before close of entry will attract a \$15 admin fee. Strictly no refund after close of entry. ICE available to order online with entry @ \$5 per bag.
STARTING TIMES:	Will be emailed and on www.eventsecretary.com.au
GENERAL CONDITIONS:	DOGS must be restrained at all times and must not be in the eating area. It is an absolute privilege to bring them as the property is a working dairy farm and respect for the generosity of landowners should be shown. All rubbish (including bailing twine) is to be placed in bins provided.

INSPECTION OF X-COUNTRY:	Saturday after 2pm on approval of TD.
YARDS:	140 yards available for the weekend. Yards must be left tidy and rubbish removed. Portable Yards are permitted for the duration of the weekend. There is Limited room for BYO yards, so those bringing own must comply with building in designated portable yard area, and this MUST be adhered to. All entries pay \$20 facility fee (non-refundable) which includes yard on first booked basis. Horse must not be left on site unattended overnight.

CAMPING:	Toilets available – no showers.
ACCOMMODATION:	8klms to Timboon approx. 25klms to Port Campbell, 18 klms to Cobden. Good choices of accommodation in Port Campbell and many eating places, there's a takeaway, pub and distillery in Timboon. You're only 30 minutes' drive from the majestic 12 apostles.
LOCATION:	590 Cobden-Port Campbell Road, Scotts Creek 3267 206.8 klms west from Westgate Bridge, Melbourne.
CATERING:	Excellent catering available all weekend. With option of evening meal on Saturday night. Meals must be pre-booked via entry.
PRESENTATIONS:	First place horse in hand. All place getters must be well attired and present to receive prizes. Presentations will be conducted at the conclusion of all classes. No posting of prizes.
COURSE CLOSURE:	Not open for schooling.
REFUNDS:	 Prior to close of entries: refund less \$15 administration fee per horse withdrawn. After close of entries only facility fees will be refunded. If the place can be filled from the wait list, refund of entry less 20watermakr% administration fee. Eventing Levy will NOT be refunded.
