- All entries to be lodged via Nominate online
- Membership, stabling, and camping fees, must be paid with entries via Nominate
- Breed, height and membership papers must be lodged via Nominate and made available upon request
- Waiver forms to be signed and lodged on Nominate - a wristband will be issued upon presentation of your Show Ticket at the horse gate (at the horse office if Wednesday) - **no wristband no entry into ring.**

HORSE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of Victoria Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at www.vicagshows.com.au. Peak body rules apply to some disciplines as outlined on the schedule page for each discipline. Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other VIC shows.

INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS:

To Be Completed on Nominate.

The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying Mildura Show Society Inc and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed

by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age and any other individual expected to interact with horses during the show. ALSO, all competitors must complete a Horse Health Declaration, each horse with which the competitor has brought onto the Showgrounds must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.

1. All those entering the arena at Mildura Show are required to obtain a wrist band prior to entering the arena regardless of age or intended activity as evidence of completion of waiver forms. Any person not wearing a wristband may be asked to leave the arena immediately and will forfeit all entries until such time as they have obtained a wristband.

Indemnity wrist bands must be collected from the demountable on the edge of the horse arena before entering the arena.

2. Accidents: Competitors are required to advise the Chief Steward and the Horse Shed of any falls or injuries and complete an Incident Form immediately after the incident.
3. Under Saddle Age Limit: The ASC recommends a lower age limit of 3 years of age (as at the date of the competition) for leading rein and 5 years of age for independent riding.
4. Entry: Must be completed online at <https://nominate.com.au/>
5. **Late Entries:** Where permitted within the applicable ring, late entries must be made via Nominate by **12:00 pm on the day prior to the class** and are subject to stable availability. Where specified, late entries will incur **double the advertised entry fee**. Where no late entry fee is specified, and subject to Ring Steward approval, a **\$20 late fee** will apply. **No late entries will be accepted on the day of the class.**
6. Scratching: Competitors are required to advise the Ring Steward or Chief Horse Steward that they are withdrawing from an event as soon as practicable. In the event of a scratching, entries fees will be forfeited and

- are unable to be transferred to another or competitor.
7. There will be no entry fees refunded after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of completion of event.
 8. Competitors must advise the Chief Steward of any changes to their entries. Failure to do so will result in an invoice being issued, which must be paid before prize money will be distributed.
 9. Refusal of Entry/Alteration of Schedule/Prizes: The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances. The Society is not responsible for the non-delivery of Sponsor's trophies/prizes. Should there be any reason to suspect that any exhibit is either diseased or dangerous, the Society reserves the right to isolate, refuse entry to and/ or remove the exhibit from the ground at the expense of the exhibitor.
 10. Prizes: The committee reserves the right to decline to pay prize money on classes with less than three competitors unless otherwise stated.
 11. Judge's Decision/Discretion: The judge is empowered to withhold any or all prizes in anywhere the exhibits are, in his/her opinion, unworthy of the prize, and at all times the judge's decision will be final. A judge has the discretion to ask that a led or performance exhibit and handler/rider/driver be ordered to leave the ring if he/she considers the animal is unruly and/or likely to cause an accident.
 12. Approaching Judges: No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before, during or after judging except through the Chief Steward.
 13. The Judges decision is final. Please follow the protest protocol outlined below.
 14. District/Local Classes: Rider class: the rider must have been resident for at least three months prior to the show within 100km of the Mildura Harness Racing Track to be eligible to compete in district classes. Horse class: The horse must be permanently stabled for at least 3 months prior to the show within 100km of the Mildura Harness Racing Track to be eligible to compete in district classes
 15. Novice horse, pony or rider is one (VAS ruling), which has not won a 1st placing, competing singly, in any EA so mentioned show or gymkhana.
 16. Intermediate: An Intermediate rider has not won a first, second or third prize at any Royal Show.
 17. Ridden Show Hunters and Ridden Show Hacks: At the beginning of each calendar year an exhibitor MUST choose the category for their exhibit, EITHER Show Hunter or Show Hack, when competing at an Ag Shows VIC Affiliated Agricultural Show or supplementary event.
 18. Ridden Show Hunters - Hack, Galloway, Pony Horses in Show Hunter classes may not also compete in Ridden Show Hack classes.
 19. Ridden Show Hacks - Hack, Galloway, Pony Horses in Show Hack classes may not also compete in Show Hunter classes.
 20. Stallions: Stallions must be always wearing a bit when being led and must be under the control of a person 18 years of age or older. Stallions must be clearly identifiable per Equestrian Australia's Stallion Safe Practice & Identification guidelines. They must be always supervised and placed in an allocated Stable. They are not eligible to compete in ridden classes unless their eligibility is specifically stated in the schedule. This includes minis.
 21. Ponies with Adult Riders: Ponies may be ridden by adults unless otherwise stated in the schedule.
 22. Lateness to the Ring: Competitors must be ready when called. Once judging has

- commenced, a competing horse shall not be led, ridden or driven into or out of the judging ring without the permission of the judge and/or the Chief Steward.
23. Leaving The Ring: If a led horse should drag or escape its handler or a ridden or driven horse take control of or unseat its rider and leave the ring, it is usually disqualified from the class.
24. Horse Measuring: No official measuring will take place at the show, but, if a question about height arises, proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof, a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Chief Steward.
25. Breed Registration: Registration documents for horses in breed classes must be produced when required by a Steward. It is the competitor/owner's responsibility to ensure relevant memberships for their exhibits Breed society or registry is financial at time of competition.
26. Attire: Competitors must be appropriately attired for the competition in which they are competing.
27. Helmets: EA Approved safety helmets must be worn at all times while mounted anywhere on the show grounds. Refer to Equestrian Australia approved safety standards for current approved helmets for the discipline entered. Please visit www.equestrian.org.au for more information.
28. Footwear: All competitors, and support person(s) must wear appropriate enclosed footwear when holding or leading a horse. Riding boots with smooth or almost smooth soles and heels must be worn whilst mounted.
29. Cruelty: Persons who are considered by the Chief Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground. No horse will be permitted to compete if, in the opinion of the Chief Steward, it is in poor health or condition.
30. Drugs: Drug testing may be carried out at this show. As per the appeals process and any costs associated with the swabbing will be liable of the individual that lodged the appeal and/or the owner. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC disputes & disciplinary regulation will be investigated by the ASC disciplinary committee. Where a horse or rider is registered with a peak body, the test results may be passed to that peak body.
31. Unsafe animals: If a horse is out of control and deemed unsafe by a Judge and/or the Chief Steward it must be removed from the Showgrounds as soon as practicable at the expense of the exhibitor.
32. Prohibited Relationship: No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.
33. Coaching: Please refer to current EA guidelines.
34. Proper Conduct: Any person who behaves offensively on the Showground may be expelled from the ground. The matter may be investigated by the Society or/and ASC Disciplinary committee and penalties may be imposed.
35. Protests: A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged in writing with the Chief Steward no later than sixty minutes after the judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. The Chief Steward must be provided with the exact nature of the complaint and act, if necessary, to maintain competitive fairness. The Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the Protests Committee, which shall comprise the President of the Society, or a Vice President and two other members of the General Committee. A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of the Chief Steward may be lodged in writing with the Secretary no later than 6 pm on the day of judging. All protests, complaints or appeals shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$100 which shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint, or appeal proves to be frivolous or

vexatious. A matter lodged this way shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24 hours of lodgement and the decision of the Protest Committee shall be final. No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision.

36. Veterinary Costs: In the case of an exhibit requiring veterinary inspection/treatment whilst at this event exhibitors agree that all costs incurred are their responsibility.
37. Age of Horses: The age of all horses shall be calculated from 1st August in the year in which it was foaled.
38. Over Mounting: Will not be tolerated. Riders deemed to be too tall or too heavy will not be permitted at the Judge's discretion.
39. Equestrian Australia Classes: All Horses, Riders & Owners must be registered with Equestrian Australia to be eligible to compete in Official & Junior classes. A copy of current EA Certificate or Registration must be produced on request. Current Performance Cards must be available on request. Prize money will be withheld until documents are presented.

44. Drones are not permitted at Mildura Show, unless prior written consent has been gained by committee.
45. Unregistered electric vehicles are prohibited on Mildura Showgrounds with the exception of approved mobility aids.

46. **Unacceptable behaviour towards judges, stewards, staff, contractors or any other Mildura Show Society volunteers will not be tolerated. This includes bullying, harassment, adverse behaviour, offensive language or physical abuse. Any person involved in these sorts of behaviours will be escorted from the showgrounds and may be banned from future shows.**

47. Mildura Show Society Inc will not tolerate any malicious comments made on social media or elsewhere which includes but is not limited to; Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, TikTok, Blogs, Forums, Discussion Boards and Groups (public, private or restricted), which may ultimately bring Mildura Show Society Inc, it's events, volunteers, sponsors and competitors into disrepute. Every instance will be investigated, and action may be taken.

Prize Money

Please ensure that you have entered your Bank details on nominate, there are no cash payments. Please allow up to 6 weeks for prize money to be paid into your bank account.

STABLING

Limited brick stables are available. Bookings to be made via Nominate online and paid for with entries. A charge of \$5 per stable per day with a maximum charge cap of \$10 per day for those with more than two (2) horses. Preference will be given to stallions and distance travellers. A refundable cleaning deposit will be also charged.

Tie up stalls are required for all competitors not booking stables. These are to be selected by competitors through nominate at no charge, however a refundable cleaning deposit will be charged.

NOTE: Only shavings or sawdust to be used in stables and stalls.

If required, additional portable day yards will be provided. Horses are not to be left in Portable yards UNATTENDED, if you are leaving the grounds they are to be STABLED.

Stables and stalls must be cleaned at the end of the show. A \$50 (Stables), \$25 (Stalls) deposit per competitor booking will be paid through

nominate and returned after a clean stable inspection has occurred. We ask that all stable and cross tie stall users notify the stabling steward upon departure to allow for a timely inspection. Refund of deposit for clean stables will be returned through nominate after the show.

Repairs to damaged stables and portable panels will be charged to hirer.

Stables, stalls and portable panels are used at the risk of the handler or exhibitor. Mildura Show Society accepts no responsibility for any injury or damage suffered as a result of the use of stables, stalls and portable panels.

No horse is to be put in a stable or stall without consent of the Stabling Steward. Building of personal yards is permitted but limited space is available for this and at discretion of the Stabling Steward. **Straw permitted in personal yards only.**

Stable allocations will be monitored by the Stabling Steward. A list of stable allocations will be available at the horse demountable or through the Stabling Steward.

CAMPING

Limited Camping sites available - all bookings made via Nominate.

CONDITIONS FOR CAMPING

1. Camping applications to be made via Nominate with entries.
2. Camping bookings will be confirmed before the show.
3. All electrical leads & equipment must be currently tested & tagged by a licensed tester.
4. All leads to be covered or disconnected during the day.
5. Fires are not permitted on the Mildura Showgrounds.
6. Campers are responsible for cleaning up their area prior to departure. Failure to clean up may result in a cleaning charge equivalent to

the cost of the cleanup and loss of allocation at future shows.

7. Campers are required to act within VIC laws, rules and regulations for public facilities at all times whilst camping at Mildura Showgrounds.

Memorial Trophy for Outstanding District Junior Equestrian Competitor of the Year.

Valuable Trophy awarded for the most Outstanding District Junior. Open only to district Junior Competitors under the age of 18 yrs.

Where a non- district exhibitor gains placings in any event which carries points for this trophy, the next placed District Exhibitor will be allotted the points for the Trophy as if the exhibitor had won the event. Only wins on the flat, in Junior Jumping Events and Novelty Events will be counted.

Wins in Smartest on Parade, Fancy Dress, Encouragement or Teams events do not carry points.

Championship points are only for Champion Junior Riders and District Junior Riders.

In the Event of points gained being equal, the competitors with the highest equal points will be paraded before the Judge and will be judged for their control on the flat and in jumping.

Competitors to be judged, solely on their riding ability.

Mount, Saddlery or Costume will not be considered, but special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse.
