# **NOTES FOR APPLICANTS**

## - INTERNATIONAL COMPETITORS LICENCE.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Possession of an International Competitor's Licence will indicate to overseas Federations that you have the approval of Equestrian Australia to compete in events up to *National* level.

If you enter for, or are invited to compete in *International* Events, you will nee EA authorisation for each event, and the National Office will authorise your entries directly. If you are planning to compete at FEI level events while you are overseas, please contact this office before you leave, as the process for entering these events can be complicated.

Some countries, such as Germany, may ask you to have a different form filled in by EA before they allow you to compete. If this happens, send the form directly to EA with a request that it be completed and returned to you. This will be done without delay but don't forget to provide a return address or fax number.

## THE PROCEDURE

Issue of an International Competitor's Licence is not automatic. Equestrian Australia has an obligation under the FEI Rules to issue licences only to those people who are capable of competing at the level indicated, without danger to themselves, to others, or to their horses.

In general, licences will only be issued to competitors with proven performances at events in Australia.

Licences are issued for up to one year. Depending on the time of year the application is lodged, the licence will be issued either for a calendar year, or, from the month the application is received by EA to the same month in the next year (i.e October – October).

# **HOW TO APPLY**

The PDF application form should be printed out, filled in and sent back to Equestrian Australia National office, together with credit cards details or a cheque made payable to EA, for \$60 (inclusive of GST).

If your licence is to be sent to you in Australia before you leave, please advise us of your overseas contact details as soon as they are available.

If possible, please provide the name, telephone and/or fax number of a contact person in Australia, just in case there is a need to check details while you are away.

In general we will not issue licences on short notice!
