

1.1 This Competition comprises two phases run without interruption, each at an identical or different speed, the finishing line for the first phase being identical with the starting line for the second phase. 1.2 The first phase is a course of 7 to 9 obstacles with or without combinations. The second phase takes place over 4 to 6 obstacles, which may include one combination. 1.3 Athletes penalised in the first phase are halted by ringing the bell after they have jumped the last obstacle or when the time allowed for the first phase has been exceeded, after crossing the finishing line of the first phase. They must stop after crossing the first finishing line. 1.4 Athletes not penalised in the first phase continue the course, which finishes, after crossing the second finishing line.

ENTRY: \$5 per round WEC members/day members (max 3 heights per horse).

\$8 non-members (max 3 heights per horse)

PRIZES: Ribbons to 4th Place. Prize Money to 3rd place.

Condition of Entry to Show Jumping: Rider must be a member of Equestrian Australia (relevant state body), or Wimmera Equestrian Club. Day memberships to Wimmera Equestrian Club are available for \$10.

- ➤ The **2021 4CYTE™ Country Classic** will be run under the auspices of Equestrian Australia and conducted in accordance with:
- **DRESSAGE:** EA General & Dressage Rules and Official Procedures for Dressage Competitions as amended. Please make sure you are familiar with these rules.
- > SHOWJUMPING: EA National Jumping Rules (all classes are unofficial).
- ➤ Your entry fee, less an administration fee per horse, will be refunded upon presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate, which must be presented to the Secretary no later than 2 days after the competition.
- ➤ **Liability -** Neither the organising committee, EA, nor the owner/lessees of the venue accept any liability for accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, persons or property whatsoever.
- Doping Attention is drawn to EA Rules. Random swabbing may take place.
- ➤ FEI Champions will be categorised into Small Tour (Prix St Georges/Inter I) and Big Tour (Inter A/Inter B/Inter II/Grand Prix). Champions will be determined by the combination of FEI class across both days of the championships. FEI Championships will not be divided into AOR, Open and Closed Restricted it will be combined as one OPEN champion.
- ➤ **EA Champions** will be awarded for each level and division (AOR, Open and Closed Restricted), calculated by the combination of **all** tests at each level on both days.
- ➤ Interschools: Athletes must hold the appropriate level of EA membership (or become a day member of Wimmera Equestrian Club cost \$10 per horse/rider combination) and be currently enrolled as a student in a school. Interschool competitors to wear school jumper/jacket and may not ride Stallions. Dressage classes only for Interschools competitors.
- ➤ The draw will be strictly adhered to and dressage riders must present to **the gear check**, preferably 15 minutes prior to their specified times, or immediately after your test. No gear check is required for Led and Ridden Showcase or Show Jumping.
- The **draw** will be emailed to competitors and available via facebook.
- ➤ The Wimmera Equestrian Club committee reserves the right to refuse entries and make alterations to the program at its discretion.

- ➤ Camping: Unpowered camp sites are available at the competition venue. Powered camp sites and cabins are available at Riverside Holiday Park, which adjoins the Dimboola Showgrounds. For bookings ph: 03 53891 416.
- ➤ Yards are limited. Yards are used at your own risk. Bookings can be made for yards at the time of entry via nominate. You can build your own yards at no cost. EA rules apply.
- > Prizes: Rosettes and/or Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place for tests available.
- ➤ Dressage Tests and Competition Rules: Copies of Dressage Test Sheets and the Equestrian Australia National Dressage Rules can be found on the Equestrian Australia website: http://www.equestrian.org.au/Dressage-rules
- ➤ Show Jumping Competition Rules: Copies of Equestrian Australia National Jumping rules can be found on the Equestrian Australia website: https://www.equestrian.org.au/Jumping-rules
- ➤ Closed Restricted division: This division allows riders to compete without being a members of Equestrian Australia. To participate in this division, riders must be a current financial member of the Wimmera Equestrian Club, or a Day Member of the Wimmera Equestrian Club (\$10 fee). Closed Restricted riders may substitute riding jackets for club shirts, polos, vests or jackets. All other attire must be in accordance with the aforementioned Equestrian Australia National Dressage Rules.
- Members of Wimmera Equestrian Club and Day Membership to Wimmera Equestrian Club does not provide the participant with any Personal Accident insurance coverage. Equestrian is a dangerous sport. You must have your own personal accident coverage (i.e. membership to Equestrian Australia, HRCAV or Pony Club).
- ➤ 'Come and Try Dressage' Tests: This is a special class restricted to riders who are not members of Equestrian Australia and who do not usually ride EA dressage tests. Our target riders are Pony Club Members, HRCAV members, Adult riders and Child riders who are competently riding unassisted. Tests may be called for this class. Our conditions of entry to these tests are: 1. You are not a member of Equestrian Australia, and 2. You have not ridden an EA test in competition (official or unofficial) in the 6 months prior to this event. This is for riders wanting to try out dressage and to try out attending our club dressage events in a friendly and stress-free environment. Attire for this event is as per Equestrian Australia Dressage Rules, with the exception that riders my substitute the requirement for a riding jacket, for a polo or shirt. The addition of a vest is also acceptable. Riders in this class must be a member of Wimmera Equestrian Club. Day membership is available for \$10 per rider.
- ➤ Children's Dressage Test: This is a special class for riders 12 years and under who require the assistance of a side walker or leader. We have borrowed this idea from our neighbouring Mid South East Dressage Club and the test is available upon request by emailing weedressage1@gmail.com. Riders in this class must be a member of Wimmera Equestrian Club. Day membership is available for \$10 per rider.
