

Jumping Committee Summary of Business June 13th, 2023

The EV Jumping committee met on June 13th, 2023, and is pleased to submit the following summary of business.

JVC are involved in a discussion regarding an annual refresher program for jumping officials. It has been proposed that this refresher course would be conducted on a yearly basis during the June – August period. Additionally, there is a desire to expand the program beyond a single state and include officials from other states as well. This indicates a broader vision for the refresher program, with the intention of involving officials from multiple regions.
Starting July 1st, Base Horse Registration will be mandatory for all jumping classes, including those under 1.05m. While members jumping under 1.05m will not require a jumping license, they will need to ensure their horses have Base Horse Registration. For all other disciplines, base Horse Registration is for non-competing horses, and allows members to register young or breeding horses, secure their name and have their details registered for biosecurity and theft security purposes. Being base registered does not affect a member's insurance in any way as insurance is attached to the member, not the horse.
An EOI for Jumping State Titles is underway and is nearly complete. There is a desire to send it out to clubs and venues as soon as possible.
There is a vacant seat within the JVC committee. The intention is to fill this seat with a young person, indicating a desire to include youth representation in the decision-making process. The position will become available in six months' time, aligning with the next committee election.
