

AIMS:

- o Training, support and development jumping program for riders 12 years and under
- o The program offers quality coaching with EA accredited coaches as well as theory on horse care and rider development skills
- o The program has a great social and jumping community spirit for riders and their families
- o Training is run in conjunction with the State and Development Squad weekends conducted between April – October.

SQUADETTES MEMBER REQUIREMENTS

- o Applicants must be current financial members of EA and are eligible to participate as Squadettes members until December of the year in which they turned 12 years
- o Cost is \$75.00 per training day. Inclusive of venue facility fee, three training riding sessions and horse care, nutrition and equine educational guest speakers. *Please note: July training is a weekend school holiday opportunity
- o Camping and stabling are additional costs and payable when registering for training day online. Minimum attendance required to 4 out of 6 Squadettes training days.

Riders must agree to fully participate in funded Squadettes activities as per signed Squadettes agreement

Successful applicants will receive a letter of acceptance and a medical form to complete and return.

Each Squadettes training day will be posted as an event online and you will be required to book online to confirm your attendance and payment. Bookings will cut off 1 week prior to training weekend.
