Entries will be capped at 60 per class. Classes begin at 8:30am each day. The venue is Lethbridge Equestrian Centre, 30 Ackland Road, Lethbridge. Look for the "Indoor Equestrian Centre" road signage on the Midland Highway. The arena is 60 x 30 m indoor. Lighting can be used if required. The event is hosted by Lethbridge Equestrian Centre Club which is affiliated with Equestrian Victoria (EV).

Rules:

This event will be conducted under Equestrian Australia (EA) rules.

Members of EA may compete in all classes 1-12 and must be riding EA registered horses to compete in official classes 5, 6, 11 and 12. EA membership is not required to compete in unofficial classes 1-4, 7-10, however proof of insurance is required. Current EA membership is sufficient proof of insurance. Members of PCAV may compete in unofficial classes if they bring a current PCAV membership card as proof of insurance. Membership of Lethbridge Equestrian Centre Club meets requirements for insurance purposes. Horse registration is not required for unofficial classes.

Correct attire must be worn in official classes. Approved helmets and riding boots must be worn in all classes.

The venue:

Lethbridge Equestrian Centre is located at 30 Ackland Road, Lethbridge, Victoria 3332.

Set on 8 hectares in the Golden Plains region, north-west of Geelong, Lethbridge Equestrian Centre features a 60 x 30 m indoor arena, day yards, stables, all weather parking and a café and BBQ area. For the Showjumping Festival competitors will be required to park in the paddock area. Camping is permitted. Build you own yards.

All jumping classes will be in the indoor arena. A warm up arena will be set up in the paddock.

How to get there:

Lethbridge Equestrian Centre is in Lethbridge, Victoria, on the Midland Hwy (A300) between Geelong (30 km) and Ballarat (55km). The street address is 30 Ackland Road. The indoor arena is visible from the highway. Ackland Road intersects the Midland Hwy.

For the Showjumping Festival a side gate will be open to allow paddock parking. Access is easy for floats and medium trucks, but very large trucks will need to take Quarry Rd and turn right into Ackland Road for easier access into the side gate. There are a few large rocks in the paddock so be careful and drive slowly, especially after dark.

Camping:

You are welcome to camp at Lethbridge Equestrian Centre. Power is not available. Please think of others if using a noisy generator.

There are some lines in the paddock where water pipes have been laid and one line from the paddock corner to the house where electricity has been laid. Be careful if you are building horse yards and driving in star pickets. Ask if you are not sure.

Catering:

Lethbridge Equestrian Centre will keep a BBQ going and will also provide other refreshments for sale. We will aim to make sure that there is food available on site throughout the event. There is a small general store in Lethbridge that serves hot food but no pubs or restaurants. There are many options in Meredith and Bannockburn.
