<p><b>Young Ambassador – Show Horse</b></p>	<p>An engagement program is currently in review, with the Show Horse Committee confirming that the current Young Ambassador engagement program will be communicated with the winner before the end of the year. The engagement plan will outline a number of potential engagement and participation initiatives for the Show Horse Young Ambassador to become involved in and assist with.</p>
<p><b>EV Office</b></p>	<p>Eliza has commenced her new role as the Education and Pathways Officer for Equestrian Victoria. Eliza will become the primary contact at EV for any courses, workshops, seminars and accreditation enquiries. The Show Horse Committee is currently reviewing a calendar for seminars and clinics, which they will collaborate on with Eliza from EV.</p>
<p><b>OTT and Owner Rider Show (December)</b></p>	<p>Schedule planning is under way, with some amendments expected to be finalised shortly. With judges secured,</p> <p>In addition to the clarification of the Owner Rider classes, height classes will be included + a potential OTT Working Hunter feature class.</p>

<p><b>OTT Working Hunter Class for Future Shows</b></p>	<p>A proposal was made to implement a Twilight Feature Class for an OTT Working Hunter class (Show Jumper or Eventer) at upcoming Show Horse events. Plans have commenced to include this as a class for upcoming shows.</p>
