Conditions of Senior Jumping Events:

Nominations close Tuesday 22nd February at 5:00pm for all events. Horses names and EA registration number to be provided on entry form.

Payment of Entry Fees: Entry paid via: www.nominate.com.au. Please check our Facebook page or website for further details.

No more than 3 classes/day per combination.

Entry fees are exclusive of any other fees, e.g. camping fees, stall fees.

Entry Fees not refundable except in the following circumstances: -

- Where withdrawal of entry is endorsed in writing by a Doctor or a Veterinary officer on the grounds of injury to horse or rider, or if the horse becomes ineligible to compete in the event.
- Cancellation of the event prior to the commencement of the event.
- Entrant withdraws from event due to experiencing COVID19 symptoms

Exhibitors who are exhibiting in the name of a GST registered entity e.g. a horse stud, are required to provide their ABN on the entry form so an appropriate tax invoice can be issued

Confirmation of entries: unless the competitor advises to the contrary prior to the first event of the competition, all nominations will be deemed to be confirmed and, except where elsewhere provided, competitors shall be liable to payment of all relevant entry fees. Substitution of entries after nominations have closed will be permitted.

The Draw will be conducted on the basis of nominations. Late entries will be listed at the discretion of the Chief Steward.

All complaints, to be valid, must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$50.

Competitors are covered under the Society's Public Liability Insurance Policy. See Preamble to Schedule.

Horse Stalls: Stalls are available for the use of exhibitors. Preference will be given to those Exhibitors whose place of residence is more than 90kms from Warrnambool. Exhibitors using stalls and camping facilities are required to pay a fee of Camping \$25.00 per night. A limited number of Stallion Boxes are available and must be booked via online entry (www.nominate.com.au) in advance at a cost of \$15 per box per night. This advance booking also applies to ordinary stalls, these being \$10 per yard per night. All yards and stalls are open fronted & only available to horses entered for the event. Fees must be paid in advance with Entry Fees.

The Society reserves the right to reserve stalls in special circumstances. Due to limited space being available for float parking, temporary horse yards are only allowed to be erected if all stables & yards are fully booked. Yards must be panel type not star picket and electrical tape as per EA regulations, and must be dismantled on show days by 6.am.

NEW: Compulsory Medical Levy is payable \$10.00 per rider

Horse transports must be parked as directed by parking attendants and within the parking areas reserved for this purpose.

PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

Show jumping Section: Prize cards will be presented at the conclusion of each event and prize money can be collected from the Cashier/Steward on presentation of prize cards.

Prize money not collected within 30 days after the event will be forfeited.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ANIMAL EXHIBITORS

Forbidden substances: The use of tranquilisers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance or behaviour of animals is forbidden. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the owners' risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under veterinary supervision.

Participation (including passive participation) in animal handling and/or physical competitions and/or Events at an agricultural show and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities contain elements of risk, both obvious and inherent.

Physical competitions and activities, Events and use of the Suppliers' facilities are all dangerous recreational activities. This document is a risk warning for the purpose of the Wrongs Act (1958) VIC. This risk warning is given by or on behalf of the Suppliers.

This document acts as an exclusion of liability under the Wrongs Act (1958) VIC if the services supplied by the Suppliers are supplied without reasonable care and skill.

Section B - Participant's acknowledgements

By signing this document I acknowledge that:

Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a recreational activity for the purposes of the Wrongs Act (1958) VIC.

1. I participate in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities at my own risk.
2. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a hazardous activity and involves a significant risk of physical harm and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me and others.
