SUBSTANCE NAME	CURRENT EPSL CATEGORY	PROPOSED EPSL CATEGORY	COMMENT
Deslorelin	Controlled Medication	Remove from List	GnRH agonist – other similar products not listed
Cyclosporin	Not listed	Controlled Medication	Systemic immunosuppressant
Tropicamide	Not listed	Controlled Medication	Anticholinergic – potential for abuse
Pitcher Plant preparation	Not listed	Controlled Medication	Putative analgesic properties. Potential to affect performance, welfare concern
Delmadinone acetate	Not listed	Controlled Medication	Synthetic steroidal progestin with anti-androgenic properties; decreases testosterone concentration. Potential to affect performance
Fentanyl	Banned	Controlled Medication	Licensed product now available in animals, change of classification required
Suxibuzone	Listed as Phenylbutazone (unclear)	Controlled Medication	Clarification, currently included with Phenylbutazone (suxibuzone is a pro-drug of phenylbutazone)
Chlormadinone acetate	Not listed	Controlled Medication	Synthetic steroidal progestin with anti-androgenic properties; decreases testosterone concentration. Potential to affect performance
Morphine	Banned	Controlled Medication	Now considered to be regularly used in equine clinical practice (anaesthesia and analgesia)
